Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to MCI's letter No.MCI-34(41)(R-12)/2015-Med./105275 dated 30.04.2016 on the subject mentioned above and convey the approval of the Central Government for Renewal of Permission for admission of 2<sup>nd</sup> Batch of 150 MBBS students for the academic year 2016-17 at Hinduhridayasamrat Balasaheb Thackeray Medical College And Dr. R N Cooper General Hospital, Mumbai under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nasik.

2. The permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of 150 students during the academic session 2016-17. The next batch of students in MBBS course will be admitted in the college only after permission of Central Government for renewal/recognition.
3. The Government Medical College (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of MCI and the Central/State Government.
