The newly established state-of-the-art Central Library is situated in the new building of HBT Medical College and enables learning and advancement of knowledge. The library is equipped with modern technology and provides various library services considering standards given by the 'National Medical Council'. It can be termed as a 'Hybrid library' with the best of print and digital collection.

For hassle free transactions, a library facilitates an automated library system using library management software called SLIM. It caters to the information needs of Medical Professionals, Students and Faculty. With area of 3200 Sq.mts, it provides separate reading rooms for undergraduate, post-graduate and faculty members, a compact stacking room with a capacity of more than one lakh books, periodicals, the internet and a digital library.

LIBRARY FACILITIES

Reading Space

- Library has separate reading area for UG students, PG students and Faculty.
- Reading area at Ground floor of the library will be available 24/7 for the students.
- Library has Open Access system. It is under CCTV surveillance 24/7.
- Library building is fully air-conditioned.

Remote Access

- The Online Journals and Databases subscribed by the library can be accessed by users off campus with remote login.

Digital Library

- Digital Library is available for the users where they can access computers and internet.
- Library provides 52 internet nodes for the users to access internet in the library.
- Students can access 'Medical Literature Analysis and Retrieval System (MEDLARS)' from the library. MEDLARS search services are available around the world without charges.

Library Automation

- Library has used SLIM Library management system to automate the library functions.
- Library provides computerized issue and return of books.
- Library provides Online Public Access Catalogue (WEB OPAC) to search for books and other materials available in the library.

Home Lending and Book Bank Facility

- Home Lending and Book Bank facility provided by library to the users.

Photocopy and Binding Facility

- Library provides Photocopy and Binding facility.

Reference Services

- A library arranges display of latest editions of books & newly arrived periodicals alphabetically and make it available to be read in library premises.
- Library provides reference services to the users. Students can request required article, books or any other materials through reference of their Head of the department. They can send request on hbtmcclib@gmail.com

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Programs

- Library provides user orientation program for newly admitted students.
- Library organizes book exhibition for the users.

LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS

- ✓ Users should write their name in the visitor's register every time.

- ✓ If users have taken a book from the library for reading in library reading area, they should deposit their I-card/library card at the counter and collect it while leaving.
